



**SEARCH FOR THE PRIVATE SECTOR REPRESENTATIVE (SPSR)
TO REPRESENT THE PRIVATE SECTOR TO THE J.H. CERILLES STATE COLLEGE
(JHCSC) BOARD OF TRUSTEES (BOT)**

CALL FOR NOMINATION

The **J.H. CERILLES STATE COLLEGE (JHCSC)** is currently accepting nominees for **one (1) Private Sector Representative** who will represent the **Private Sector in the Board of Trustees**. Nomination form is available in the Office of the Secretariat of the PSR Search Committee.

Nominees for the Private Sector Representative must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Must be a Filipino citizen and a prominent resident of Zamboanga del Sur.

Operational definitions of “**resident**” are the following: (a) the one who owns/rents a house and lot in Zamboanga del Sur and (b) the one whose ancestors/immediate family members (i.e. parents, siblings and relatives up to the 4th level of consanguinity) live in and are considered registered voters in Zamboanga del Sur of which competent local authorities could certify that the nominee continues to maintain links with and visit the province at least once a year.

2. Must be at least 35 years old but not more than 70 years old;

3. Must be a person of unquestioned integrity and probity; and must not have been convicted of any administrative offense or crime;

4. Must be distinguished in his/her profession(s) or field(s) or chosen specialization;

5. Must be from the industry, business or profession related to the mandate and allied mandates of JH Cerilles State College;

6. Must have a solid contribution to the community;

7. Must not be connected with JHCSC in any manner for two years prior to nomination;

8. Must have an extensive record, for at least 5 years of employment, business, expertise and connection with the private sector. If the nominee was previously worked in any capacity with a government entity or was a consultant in any government undertaking or whatever in nature, the proportion of the time the nominee served in the government should not exceed one-fourth of the entire time he/she was serving in the private sector.

9. Must not in any way be presently employed or appointed to any position in any government agency or entity (national and local government-owned or controlled corporations), be it on a full-time or part-time basis, at the time of the nomination; and

10. Must explicitly manifest availability of time and commitment to the service of JHCSC (such as attendance to board meetings and other relevant activities).



NOMINATION AND DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Duly accomplished and notarized nomination form;
2. Supporting Documents

2.1 Curriculum Vitae with a recent photo of nominee with duly certified documents in support of data specified therein (e.g. academic records, part and current employment/service records, awards received, SEC Registration of companies owned by nominee etc.);

2.2 Certification that nominee is not connected with the JHCSC to be secured from the HR Office of the JHCSC;

2.3 Certification that nominee is not currently employed in any government agency/office (self-certification); and

2.4 Original NBI Clearance;

3. Nominees' Conformance – Nominees should indicate their acceptance of the nomination by signing their conformance on the designated portion of the notarized nomination form.

Nominators shall submit their nomination and all supporting documents of the nominees to the Secretariat of the Search Committee for Private Sector Representative (SPSR), located at the Administrative Building, J.H. Cerilles State College, Mati, San Miguel, Zamboanga del Sur not later than **October 30, 2018** at 5 PM. The SCPSR shall only consider nominations with complete supporting documents.
